

AQUATIC EDUCATION PROGRAM POLICY

Rationale:

Grades Foundation/Students at ENPS will participate in an intensive five consecutive day sequential program at the Peter Krenz Leisure Centre aimed at providing water safety and familiarisation skills.

Purpose:

- 1. To promote a positive attitude towards learning water safety.
- 2. To develop an awareness that water recreational activities are enjoyable and assist our health and fitness.
- 3. To teach children practical skills which will enable them to be safe in and around water environments.
- 4. To develop confidence and self esteem so that water environments are seen as less threatening.

Guidelines for Implementation:

- 1. Foundation children will receive a water confidence program based upon the framework provided within the Health and Physical Education domain.
- 2. The Water Familiarisation and Water Safety Program is AUSTSWIM based and the lessons will be conducted by fully trained Aquatic Education Teachers.
- 3. Each of the sequential lessons will be of 40 minutes duration.
- 4. Ratios will be in accordance with the current R.L.S.S. Safe Pool Operation Guidelines.
- 5. Timing in relation to minimising disruption to classroom programs will be considered.
- 6. This program will operate in Semester 2.

Staff and Parents will be responsible for:

- 1. Ensuring that children are appropriately equipped for each lesson, e.g. bathers, towel.
- 2. Supervising students during travelling to and from the venue.
- 3. Supervision in the change rooms.
- 4. Marking and checking attendance.
