

EXTERNAL ACADEMIC EXTENSION, CHALLENGE and COMPETITIONS POLICY

Rationale:

We are always seeking ways in which to extend our more talented students There are a number of academic competitions available for students to take part in. eg. Mathematics, Science and English.

These competitions come in a variety of formats for academic challenge for students to see how their abilities compare with a cross section of their peers.

. Purpose:

- 1. To provide students with a meaningful challenge beyond their normal classroom boundaries.
- 2. To recognise outstanding academic rigour.
- 3. To stimulate students to develop their learning skills.
- 4. To assist in preparing students for future formal tests.

Guidelines for Implementation:

- 1. The nature of the competition will be screened with involvement at the discretion of the Principal.
- 1. Class teachers will be strongly encouraged to nominate possible participants.
- 2. Parents of nominated students will be invited to allow them to take part and pay the necessary fee.
- 3. In order to promote equity, all families will be advised of the holding of the competition, with parents able to nominate their child.
- 4. To ensure that students see this as a positive experience, the Principal will be responsible for the ultimate decision as to who will be invited to take part in the various competitions.
- 5. Students P-6 will be encouraged to pursue involvement in activities of a local and perhaps less formal nature. These usually take the form of formal tests or tournaments.
