Rationale:

At Eaglehawk North Primary School we value:

- 4. Teachers will strive towards the development of a differentiated learning program to allow all students to achieve success and reach their full potential.

Policies & Programs:

2. Individual student needs will be regularly monitored and addressed through our 'Student Wellbeing Program and other support processes.
